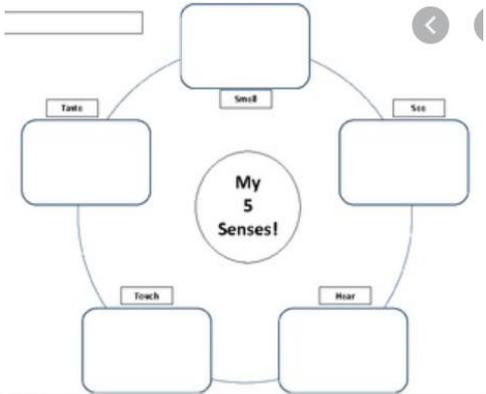


### Sizzling sentence starters:
